MINISTER: What do you believe about the Lord’s Day?

ALL: **As it is the law of nature that, in general, a proper proportion of time ought to be set apart for the worship of God, so God in his Word-by a positive, moral, and perpetual commandment binding all men in all ages— has specifically appointed one day in seven for a Sabbath to be kept holy to him. From the beginning of the world to the resurrection of Christ, the appointed Sabbath was the last day of the week. Beginning with the resurrection of Christ, the Sabbath was changed to the first day of the week, which in Scripture is called the Lord’s Day, a day to be continued until the end of the age as the Christian Sabbath.**
